

The Return of the Common Good. The Postliberal Project Left and Right

Stefan Borg, Associate Professor at the Department of Political Science at the Swedish Defence University

Stefan Borg presents his new book on postliberalism. Borg offers an intellectual history of the two main forms of postliberal thinking: a British version associated with the Blue Labour movement, with deep roots in a theological movement known as Radical Orthodoxy, and an American version mainly associated with the post-fusionist New Right. Borg emphasizes the ideological ambiguity of postliberal thinking, and argues that while the postliberal diagnosis of liberal societies resonates with both segments on the Left and Right, postliberal solutions, i.e. suggestions for alternative orders, attract more controversy.
