Raymond Tallis is a philosopher, poet, novelist and cultural critic, and a retired physician and clinical neuroscientist. He ran a large clinical service in Hope Hospital Salford and an academic department in the University of Manchester. His research, for which he was elected a Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences, focussed on epilepsy, stroke, and neurological rehabilitation. He was elected Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences. He has published fiction, poetry, and 30 books on the philosophy of mind, metaphysics, philosophical anthropology, and literary and cultural criticism. He has 4 honorary degrees: DLitt (Hull, 1997) and Litt.D. (Manchester, 2001) for contributions to the humanities; and DSc (St George's Hospital Medical School, 2015; University of East Anglia, 2017) for his research in medicine.
